EMERGENCY ACTIONS

Post emergency telephone numbers

by phones (fire, police, etc...).

Determine your family emergency contact

preferably an out of town family member or friend.

Designate emergency meeting place

for your family if unable to return home.

If there are school age children

request the school emergency plan.

Be calm and patient.

Follow advice of local emergency officials.

If the emergency occurs near your home

check for damage using a flashlight. If you smell gas or suspect a leak, turn off the main gas valve, open windows and get everyone outside quickly to a safe location.

Confine or secure your pets.

Check on your neighbors,

especially those who are elderly or disabled
