Councilor Ryan, Chairman of the Committee on Public Works, reported that NationalGrid had withdrawn their petition on Order 12 021 and 12 024. For the remaining five petitions, the committee recommends favorable action to include staff recommendations.

#### • 12 018 NationalGrid: Petition – Front and Oak Streets

Councilor Bowes read the petition request to install and maintain approximately 1,030 feet, more or less of 4 inch gas main in Front Street, Braintree, from the existing 6 inch gas main in Commercial Street, Easterly to the existing 4 inch gas main at Oak Street and approximately 515 feet more or less of 4 inch gas main in Oak Street from the proposed 4 inch gas main at Front Street Northerly to the end of the gas main at House #41. All of which to replace and abandon the existing 3 inch and 2 inch gas mains in Front Street and the 2 inch and 1½ inch gas mains in Oak Street, Braintree.

Councilor Bowes then read the following staff recommendation for the petition: BELD has no utility conflicts within the proposed scope of work. DPW notes that Front Street was recently reconstructed in conjunction with the re-opening of the Greenbush Commuter Rail Service. It is just out of the 5-year moratorium in January and is in excellent condition. Oak Street East is also in good condition. It is our recommendation that this petition should be approved with more rigorous repair specifications than our standard conditions, to include a final hot mix asphalt pavement at least 4" deep being maintained flush with the surrounding pavement for a year, and then 1 ½ inch grind and inlay to neat lines one foot beyond the trench limits at the completion of the year.

It is our recommendation that this petition should be approved with our "standard" repair specifications, with a final pavement being maintained flush with the surrounding pavement immediately (do not leave the trench down).

main in Norfolk Road from the proposed 4 inch gas main at Liberty Street Westerly to the existing 2 inch gas main at House #16. All of which to replace and abandon the existing 3 inch gas main in Liberty Street and the existing 1½ inch gas main in Norfolk Road, Braintree.

Councilor Bows then read the following staff recommendation for the petition: BELD has no utility conflicts within the proposed scope of work. DPW notes that Norfolk Road has not been resurfaced recently and is not on the short list for improvement. It is our recommendation that this part of the petition should be approved with our "standard" repair specifications, with a final pavement being maintained flush with the surrounding pavement immediately (do not leave the trench down.)

This section of Liberty Street was just out of the 5-year moratorium last January (2011) and is a main road in excellent condition. It is our recommendation that this part of the petition should be approved with more rigorous repair specifications than our standard conditions, to include a final hot mix asphalt pavement at least 4" deep being maintained flush with the surrounding pavement for a year, and then 1 ½ inch grind and inlay curb to crown along the length of disturbance at the completion of the year.

Additionally, the area of Liberty Street is at the front of the Morrison School driveway and should be completed before school begins in September.
